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1. Introduction

InresponsetoaformalrequestbyRickWessononbehalfoftheRegistrarConstituency, VeriSign,Inc.isprovidingthispapertodescribeitsproposedDo mainNameWaitListingService (WLS).Specifically,theproposedWLSisintendedtoprovideboth(1)anew,streamlined businessopportunityfortheentireregistrarcommunity,and(2)somemeasureofreliefindealing withthe"deleteddomains"issue.V eriSignbelievesthatintroductionofWLSwillbenefitall interestedconstituencies(e.g.,registries,registrars,resellers,intellectualpropertyownersand domainnameregistrants).Tothatend,weaddressthefollowingtopicsinthispaper:

- High-levelmechanicsofhowtheWLSwillbedeliveredanddistributed;
- WLSimplementationmilestonesandgo -liverequirementsforregistrars;
- Billingmodel;
- Effectsoninterestedparties; and,
- Marketpotentialandrationale.

VeriSign,Inc.,throughitsVeriSignG lobalRegistryServices("VeriSignGRS")division,is preparedoffertheWLStoVeriSignGRS'sICANN -accreditedregistrarchannel.VeriSign GRSanticipatesthatitwillofferWLSforaone -yeartest,beginninginlateMarch2002.Results willbecompi ledduringthelasttwomonthsofthetestandprovidedtoICANN.

Accordingly, VeriSignsolicitsconstructivefeedbackfromallmembersoftheRegistrar Constituency.Wehavereservedtimewithourengineeringandoperationsstaffduringthe Februaryand Marchtimeframetomovethisprojectforward.Duetothistimeschedule,we requestthatthefeedbackbereceivedbyJanuary18,2002,sothatwewillhavetimetocompile, evaluate,andrespondtocomments.CommentsmaybedirectedtoChuckGomes (cgomes@verisign.com).

2. ServiceOverviewandMechanics

WLSisaservicewherebypotentialregistrants(hereinafterreferredtoas"subscriber(s)"), through their selected, participating registrar, may purchase a subscription tied to a domain name currentlyre gistered.OnlyICANN -accreditedregistrarswouldbeabletoofferthesubscription servicefor.comand.netdomainnameregistrations.WLSsubscriptionsforthe.orgTLDwould notbeavailableduringtheone -yeartestperiod.Registrarswouldhavethe opportunitytodecide whetherornottoallowtheirresellerstooffertheservice.Registrarswouldperformall subscriptiontransactionsdirectlywithVeriSignGRS, using an interface separate from the SRS. TheRRPwouldnotbeusedintheimplementati onofWLS. Allcurrentprocesseswouldremain unchanged with one exception. A domain name registration that is subscribed to on WLS will be registeredtothesubscriberwhenthecurrentdomainnameregistrationisdeletedthroughnormal operationalproce dures. Initially, adomain nameregistration could only have one (1) subscriptionpendingatatime.Ifdemandexists,adeepersubscriptionqueuecouldbe considered for a future phase of WLS. The processes for placing and fulfilling subscription(s) wouldbeasfollows:

a. ProcessforsubscribingtoWLS:

- i. <u>Only</u>intheeventthatadomainnameisalreadyregisteredwithinthe SRS,theregistrarcheckstheWLStoseeifasubscriptionalreadyexists forthatdomainname.
 - 1. Note:Onlytwoscenarioswillpreven taregistraringood standingfrombeingabletosubmitasubscription.Thefirstisif asubscriptionalreadyexistsforaspecificdomainname.The secondisiftheselecteddomainnameregistrationdoesnot alreadyexistwithintheSRSdatabase.
- ii. If the domain name is not already subscribed to in WLS, then the registrar submits a subscription for that name to WLS.
- iii. NOTE:ThesubscriptionsubmittedtoWLSbytheregistraristhesame data(minusnameserverinformation)thatregistrarscurrentlysubmitt o "ADD"new.comand.netdomainnames. <u>WLScollectsnosubscriber</u> <u>dataand,astoday,VeriSignGRSwillhavenodirectcontactwitha</u> <u>subscriber.</u>Thesubscriberstaystheregistrar'scustomer.The subscriptionregistrarwilladdnameserverdataaftert heselecteddomain nameisactuallyregisteredintheregistryfortheregistraronbehalfof thesubscriber.
- iv. WLSnotifiestheSRSthatthedomainnameisonthesubscriptionlist. TheSRSidentifiesthenameintheSRSdatabaseasbeingasubscribed name.
- $v. \ \ WLS notifies the registrar of the successful subscription.$
- vi. Thesubscriptionregistrarnotifiesthesubscriberofthesuccessful subscription.
- vii. NOTE: The subscription is tied to a single domain name at any point in time. However, over the life of the one -years ubscription period, the subscriber <u>can change the domain name tied to the subscription</u> up to a maximum of three times.
- viii. Afterthelastdayofeachcalendarmonth,VeriSignGRSwillsendeach registraraninvoiceforallsubscriptionssuccessfullysub mittedduring thepreviousmonth.Forfurtherinformationonthebillingmodeland specificpricing,seeSection5ofthispaper.

b. Processforsubscriptionfulfillment:

- i. Adomainnameisdeletedthroughthenormalcourseofoperation(e.g., registrarsubmi tsadeleterequest).
- ii. NOTE:Anydeletiongraceperiod,asapplicable,willstillapply. However,giventhesensitivitytopermanentlylosingadomainname duetoinadvertentactionsbyaregistrar,VeriSignwillconsider implementinga15 -day"hold"grac eperiod.Specifically,domain nameslistedonWLSwouldnotactuallybe"ADD"edtotheSRS databaseuntil16daysaftertheoriginaldeletion.Duringthistime (1)thedomainnamewillremainregisteredbutberemovedfromthe zonesduetoa"Registry -Hold,"and(2)thedeletingregistrarhas extratimetoensurethatthedeletionisindeedacorrectaction.
- iii. TheSRSprocessesthedeletionandcheckstoseeifthedeletednameis onWLS.
- iv. If the name is on WLS, the name is automatically "added" to the SRS database using the registration data supplied by the subscription registrar at the time the subscription was made.

- v. Atthistime,theregistrar'sVeriSignGRSaccountisdebited\$6forthe domainnameregistrationfee.Allotherregularbusinessrulesaffe cting registrationofdomainnameswillapplyatthistime.
- vi. VeriSignGRSthennotifiesthesubscriptionregistrarofthesubscription fulfillment.
- vii. Thesubscriptionregistrarmodifiestheregistrationrecordtoinclude nameserverdataandupdatesitsWHOIS databaseinaccordancewiththe registrar'sresponsibilitiesunderthecurrentRegistry -Registrar AgreementandICANNAccreditationAgreement.
- viii. Thesubscriptionregistrarnotifiesthesubscriberofthesuccessful registration.The"subscriber"isnowareg istrant.
 - ix. ThesubscriptionwillbeclearedfromWLSandanewsubscriptioncan beplacedforthedomainnamebyanyregistrar.
- c. **SubscriptionRenewals:** Atthetimeasubscribersubmitsanapplicationfora subscription,itcanchoosewhetherornottohave thesubscriptionauto -renewat theendofitsterm.Ifthesubscriberdoesnotchooseauto -renewalattheinitial subscriptionperiod,thenitmaystillchoosethatfeatureatanytimeduringits term.Ifitneverchoosesauto -renewal,thesubscriptionw illautomatically terminate(bedeleted)whentheone -yeartermexpires.Allrenewaltermsarefor oneyear.
- d. **SubscriptionTransfers:** Inanefforttokeeptheone -yeartestassimpleas possible, VeriSignGRSdoes <u>not</u>plantoallowsubscriberstotransfe r subscriptionsfromasubscribertoanotherparty, ascanbedonewithdomain nameregistrationstoday. Aftertheone -yeartest, VeriSignGRSmayconsider implementing atransferfeature based on feedback received during the test period.
- e. **SubscriptionCa ncellations:** Asubscribermaycancelasubscriptionatanytime bysubmitting,throughitsregistrarofrecord,a"delete"requestthroughthe WLS.Pleasenotethatsubscriptionfeesarenon -refundable.
- f. **SubscriptionDisputes:** TheUniformDisputeResolu tionPolicy("UDRP") wouldnotapplytosubscriptionswithintheWLS,asthedomainnames associatedwithsubscriptionswouldnotactuallyberegistered.AstheUDRP onlyappliestoregistereddomainnames,apartywishingtodisputeadomain nameassocia tedwithasubscriptionwouldwaituntilafterthedomainnameis actuallyregisteredtoemploytheprovisionsoftheUDRP.

3. KeyMilestones(forrampingandgoinglive)

The dates associated with the milestones below assume that we receive positively constructive feedback from the Registrar Constituency by January 18,2002. Asstated earlier, VeriSignwill remain poised during the first quarter 2002 to move the WLS project forward to implementation.

- iv) Javabinariesandbuildcode -thiswillallowregistrarstobuildaworking WLSEPPJavaAPIb yusingthebuildcodes;
- v) Opensourcecode;and,
- vi) Implementationexamples.

- e. **ProductionLaunch** –03/20/02. AllregistrarsthathavesuccessfullycompletedOT&E testingwillgoliveatthesametimeontheProductionLaunchdate.

4. RegistrarGo -LiveRequirements

- a. SignedServiceAgreement; and,
- b. OT&ECertification.

5. BillingModelandFeeStructure

VeriSignGRSwillfollowawholesalebillingmodelsubstan tiallythesameasthemodelused todayfordomainnameregistrations.Specifically,VeriSignGRSwillchargeregistrarsforeach subscriptionatthetimethesubscriptionisplaced.Theregistrarswouldberesponsiblefor

promoting/retailingWLStoits resellersandcustomers.Registrarsarefreetosetacompetitive retailpriceforthisservice.

VeriSignenvisionssettingthewholesalepricebetweenVeriSignGRSandregistrarsatUS\$40 foraone -yearsubscription.Thispricepointischosenforthe followingprimaryreasons:

- VeriSignGRSmustrecoupcostsassociatedwithsecuringandmaintainingpartnersand licensestoofferWLS .
- VeriSignGRSmustrecoupitscostsofdeveloping, implementing, and maintaining the technology and resulting WLS.
- VeriSignGRSenvisionsmakingareasonableprofitonprovidingtheservice.
- Asfurtherdetailedinthemarketrationalesectionbelow, aservicesimilarbutinferiorto WLScurrentlyretailsfor\$49. Therateofuptakeontheservicebyregistrars and subscribersisincreasingevenatthiscurrentretailprice. Weenvisionthattheregistrars couldchargeahigherpriceforagreatersuccessrate(100%) offeredby VeriSignGRS's WLS. When a domain name registration is deleted within the SRS, WLS guarantees success.
- VeriSignGRSbelievesthatbecausetheWLScouldprovideanewavenuefor speculators,thepricepointshouldbesethighenoughsoasnottoencourageabusive speculationofWLSsubscriptions.

**NOTE:Unlikethescenarioregistrarsarefamiliarw ithinregisteringdomainnames,the WLSwill <u>not</u>debitaregistrar'sVeriSignGRScreditbalanceassubscriptionsareentered intotheWLS.However,theserviceagreementbetweenVeriSignGRSandeachregistrar willprovideforthecurrentregistrarpaym entsecurityvehicletobeusedbyVeriSignGRS torecoverlostfundsintheunlikelyeventofaregistrarpaymentdefaultrelatedtoWLS subscriptions.

- a. Effectonregistries:
 - i) Newservicetooffertoregistrars.
 - ii) Newrevenuestreamthatwouldsupporttheinvestmentcosts.
 - iii) ReductioninsystemusageforconstantchecksforthetargetnameonceaWLS subscriptionisplaced.
 - iv) Eliminationofmanydesireddomainnameregistrationsfromthespeculator marketsot hatthecurrentexcessivedemandonoperationalresourcesisreduced andsystemaccessismaintainedatamuchmorereasonablelevel.
- b. Effectonregistrars:
 - i) Newservicetooffertocustomers.
 - ii) Newrevenuestream.
 - iii) Reductionofregistrarsystem usageforconstantchecksonceasubscriptionis placed.
 - iv) Ensuresafairplayingfield/equivalentaccessforallregistrars,regardlessof theirmarketortechnologicaladvantage.
- c. Effectonresellers.Alleffectsonregistrarscouldflowdownto resellers.

- d. Effectonregistrants:
 - i) Currentdomainnameregistrationswouldnotbeaffectedinanyway.A registrantcouldremaintheregistrantofitsdomainnameindefinitelysolongasit continuestomeettherequirementsofitschosenregistrar
 - ii) AWLSsubscriptionwouldonlykickinwhenanameisfinallydeleted.
 - iii) Aregistrant's"rights"toitsregistereddomainnameregistrationservicewould notbeaffectedinanyway.
 - iv) Registrantsmaystilltransferorotherwisemaketheirregiste reddomainnames availableinthesecondarymarket(i.e., "auctions," persontopersontransactions, etc.).
 - v) Norestrictionsonregistrantsplacingasubscriptionontheirowndomainname registrationsiftheywish.
 - vi) Subscriptionswouldbeprocessedo nafirst -come,first -servedbasis.
- e. Effectonintellectualpropertyowners:
 - i) NonegativeeffectonIPowners.
 - ii) ProvidesalowcostalternativetothecurrentUDRPorotherdisputemechanisms forIPownerswhochoosetowaitoutacurrentdomainna meregistration.This couldbelikelyintheeventthatadomainnameregistrantisnotusingacurrent registrationincommerceorforotheractivities.

7. MarketPotentialandRationale

AstheprimarymarketfordomainnameregistrationsinallTop -LevelDomains(TLDs) approachesmaturity,commercialmarketparticipants(i.e.,registries,registrars,andresellers)are evaluatingwaystocontinuecommercialviabilityandgrowthintheircorebusinesses.Adding servicescomplementarytodomainnamere gistrationservices,whichwouldbeavailabletoall ICANN-accreditedregistrarsandwhichwouldmeetconsumer(i.e.,registrant)demand,isone importantwaytoaccomplishthesegoals.

Historically, and as is evident by the current number of domain name "checks" processed at the registryleveleachandeveryday(roughly80 -100millionchecksperday,orover95% of all transactionsperday), registrantsclearly have been and continue to look for ways to "get in line" foradomainnamewhenitbecomesava ilable.Moreover,therateofincreasefor"check" commandscontinuestogroweachandeverymonth.Manyinterestedparties, including applicants, wishtomonitorcurrent domain nameregistrations for various reasons (e.g., trademark concerns)withoutha vingtocontinuallyqueryregistrarandregistrysystemsortomonitor outdatedWHOISinformation.Duetosystemconstraintsanddesiredefficienciesthroughoutthe registrationsystem, all parties could be nefit from this new, ordered approach to hand lin g "recycled" domainnameregistrations, which does not favor speculators and robotic systems. VeriSignGRS believes WLS will address these needs and market demands of both industry and the second secoconsumers.

Suchaserviceiscurrentlyofferedbyaprivateindustry player,SnapNames,albeitwithamuch lowerefficacyratethanthatexpectedifWLSisofferedbyVeriSignGRS.Nonetheless, SnapNames'successthusfar,coupledwithotherdemandindicators,speakstoalargeapplicant marketawaitingWLS.VeriSignGRS believesthatitisreasonabletoassumethattheindustry couldseeaninitialpenetrationofatleastfive(5%)forWLSacrossthebaseofthecurrent domainnameregistrationmarket.Thisratherlargemarketoffersasubstantialup -side opportunityfor registrarsandresellers.
